This sheet is intended to aid you in planning the music for your loved one's Funeral Mass. All the selections listed below are approved for use in the Cathedral. Please discuss any requests not on this list with the Director of Music. Some common requests such as "On Eagles' Wings" or "Be Not Afraid" are served best by being accompanied on the piano, which is not available in the Cathedral or St. Michael's Chapel. Because of this, such selections would be better suited to the Vigil. Organ or other instrumental solos are not permitted during Funeral Masses. Recorded music is never appropriate for the Catholic liturgy.
