
O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended You. And I detest all my sins because of Your just punishments,



The Prodigal Son

Session 7 **Celebrating Reconciliation**



Seven Steps

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is not hard or scary! Remember that even if you forget something, the priest will help you.

Below are the steps to the Sacrament of Reconciliation. See if you can put them in order from 1-7

RECEIVE PENANCE - After you tell your sins, the priest will talk to you and give you a penance to do after Confession.

- EXAMINE YOUR CONSCIENCE Before your confession, ask God to help you to have 1 true sorrow for all your sins. Then think about your sins. Ask yourself: Have I broken any commandments? How have I failed to love God as I should? How have I hurt others?

ABSOLUTION - Last, the priest will pray the prayer forgiving you of your sins. He will hold his hands over your head. Together you will make the Sign of the Cross and then you can say "Thank you, Father." And then you can go in peace!

- CONFESS YOUR SINS Then you tell the priest your sins. Don't be afraid to tell him all your sins, starting with the worst ones. When you are finished, say, "I am sorry for these and all of my sins."
- GREET THE PRIEST When you first go into the confessional, start with the Sign of the 2 Cross. Then say, "Bless me, Father, for I have sinned. This is my first confession."
 - DO YOUR PENANCE After you leave the confessional, kneel down at a pew in the church and pray the penance that the priest gave you. Or if he gave you something to do, do it as soon as you can!
 - ACT OF CONTRITION After the priest gives you your penance, he will ask you to say your Act of Contrition. You can say it from memory, read it, or even tell God you are sorry from your heart using your own words.




