**The Resurrection Story:** Children should be able to retell the Easter story, recognizing how Jesus showed His love for us by His death and resurrection.

Jesus loved us so much that he died on the cross. He had to die for us so that we could become freed from sin.

Jesus rose from the dead on Easter Sunday! That's why we celebrate Easter. When Jesus rose from the dead, it showed us that God brings new life to those who believe in Him.

## How did the Catholic Church begin?

Jesus is God's son. He is both God and man in one person. Jesus showed us how to live our lives the way His Father (God) wants us to.

The Catholic Church was started by Jesus! We follow the teachings that Jesus and His father (God) gave us.

Before Jesus died, he said that His disciple (follower, friend) Peter would lead the church when He was gone. (Matthew 16:18) That makes Peter the Catholic Church's first Pope.

Amen.*




## The Lords Prayer (Our Father)
